## SEASONAL CAMPSITE SELECTION PROCESS 2018

## To All Onoville Marina Patrons:

In the spring of 2016, the county received an official notice from the ACOE, that the Onoville Marina Park can now allow season camping (\*more than 30 days) on 48 of its 73 sites. In addition to this notice, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) also approved the means for assigning those 48 sites to patrons, which will be accomplished on a first -come, first-served basis (lottery and longevity are not allowed). This new process includes an application, \$350 deposit, Rules and Regulations from the ACOE, and ACOE-approved seasonal camping and transient sites map. Seasonal camping will be from May 4<sup>th</sup> to September 17<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at a total season rate of \$1500 (also approved by the ACOE). The remaining balance is due by April 1<sup>st</sup>.

Seasonal Camping Packets will be provided on November 1st to all interested parties through the following methods: email, Marina website, Marina Office and regular mail (upon request). Those wishing to participate in season camping must complete and mail the application, with \$350.00 deposit check enclosed, to the Onoville Marina staff on November 27th starting at 9:00 a.m. (your local time), to be eligible for the 2018 camping season. Any applications postmarked or dated before November 27th and 9;00 a.m. (your local time), respectively, will not be accepted. All applications must be sent via certified mail so they receive a time/date stamp by the U.S. Postal Service. This will allow each patron the ability to track their application on line (via U.S. Postal Service) from acceptance at the post office through delivery at the Marina.

All applicants will be selected on a first-come, first-served basis, based on time/date stamp ("Acceptance" time). The first 48 applications will be split into two groups 1) previous patrons and 2) new patrons. Patrons, who previously had a site that was designated as seasonal for 2017, will be assigned that same site. Once this is done, all others will be contacted, in the order their "Acceptance Time", to choose from the remaining seasonal sites.

All remaining applicants that did not receive a season camping site can make a reservation on a transient site for a maximum (30) days or less (as per Paragraph 31 of the Lease Agreement) but not more than, in a 60 day time period.

Deposits will be returned to you if you are not chosen for a seasonal campsite, transient site, or if you decide to not camp before May 1st.

Reservations for transient sites are taken on a first-come, first-served basis via telephone starting the first business day of January each year.
